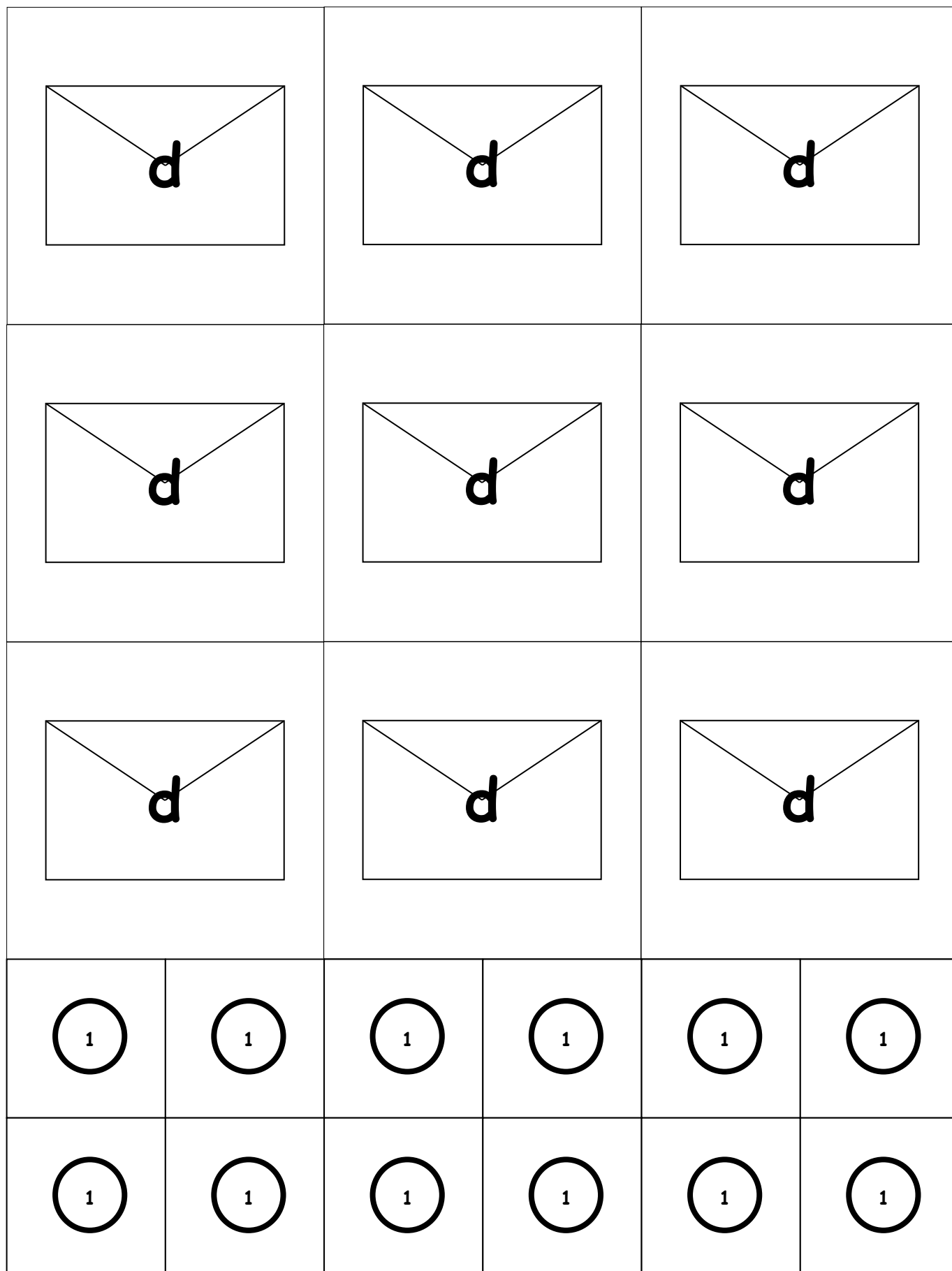


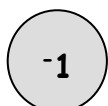
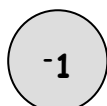
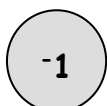
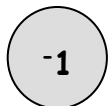
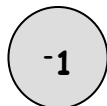
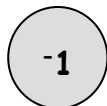
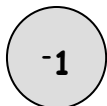
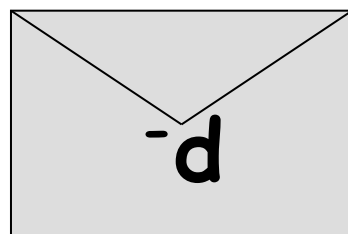
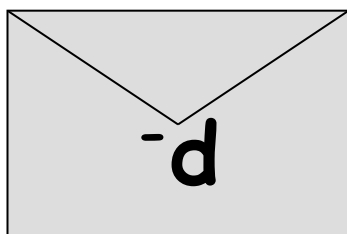
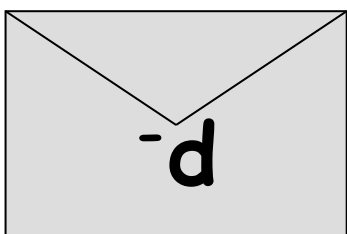
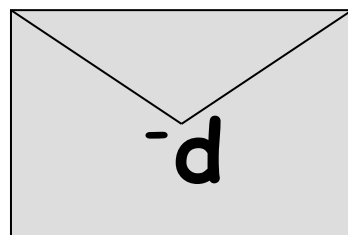
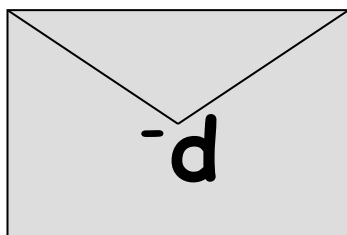
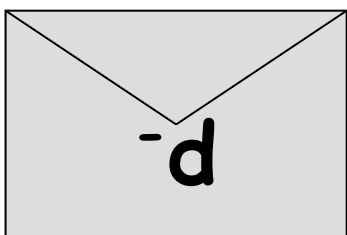
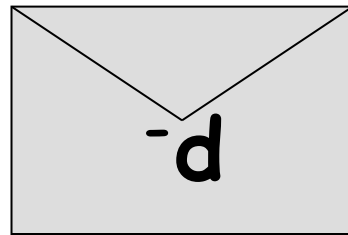
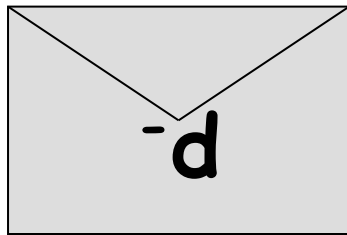
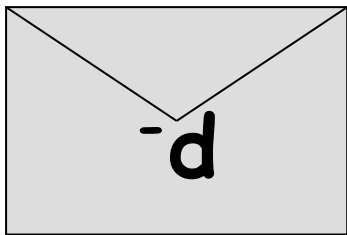
Algebra tiles - VERSION 1
