

Buzz – A Game for Practicing Multiples

Students stand around the room.

The teacher chooses a number from 3 to 9.

Students count in turn, but must say “BUZZ” if their number is a multiple of the chosen number.

If a student makes a mistake, he or she sits down. The count continues from the last correct answer.

The winner is the last student standing.

Variations

N.B. Only use these variations if the students are very adept at the classic version. They are quite tricky to play.

Students count in turn, but must say “BUZZ” if their number is a multiple of the chosen number OR if the starting number is a digit of the number.

Students count in turn, but must say “BUZZ” if their number is a multiple of the chosen number OR if the starting number is a digit of the number. If the number is both a multiple of the starting number AND contains the starting number, then the student has to say BUZZ BUZZ.
